

WHEREAS a healthy and sustainable community is a strategic priority of the Greater Sudbury City Council; and

WHEREAS the development of a Healthy Community is an extensive project that must involve the dedication and collaboration of many local experts; and

WHEREAS the implementation of the Healthy Community model has begun with the appointment of the Healthy Community Cabinet; and

WHEREAS the Healthy Community Cabinet has met and agreed with the selection of four lead agencies to represent the pillars that best match their expertise; and

WHEREAS the chosen lead agencies have mandates similar to the objectives of the Healthy Community model.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT the Social Planning Council of Sudbury (SPCS) accepts responsibility for participating as a member of the Broad Implementation Team that will champion the Healthy Community concepts associated with Social Capital/ Civic Engagement; and

FURTHER THAT the SPCS, in co-operation with the other leading agencies on the Broad Implementation Team will report their progress directly to the Healthy Community Cabinet; and

FURTHER THAT the SPCS endorses the Healthy Community Charter, which is founded on the principle that a healthy community enhances public health and sustainability.
